### **Coos County – DIRECT VISITOR SPENDING:**

- Visitors spent \$277.3 Million in 2019, +4.0% increase over 2018
  - Lodging Spend = \$60.7 Million, a 2.7% increase over 2018
- Visitors spent \$179.3 Million in 2020, -35.3% decrease from 2019
  - Lodging Spend = \$57.8 Million, only 4.9% decrease from 2019
- Visitors spent \$218.6 Million in 2021, +22% increase over 2020
  - Lodging Spend = \$69.7 million, a 29.4% increase over 2020 AND a 14.8% increase over 2019!





**Coos County – DIRECT VISITOR SPENDING - 2022:** 

- Visitors spent **\$295.9** Million in 2022
  - **1** 36.1% increase over 2021
  - 3,630 Coos County Jobs Supported
  - \$12.5 Million in Tax Revenues
    - \$2.1 Million Local 1 21% over 2021, 1 31.5% over 2019
    - \$10.4 Million State
  - Gas price increases in 2022
  - More Visitors arriving on Flights into OTH





That was 2022, from late 2022 through May 2023, however, we have seen a **decline in travelers to our area, to the coast, and to all of Oregon**. Coos County has been down as much as 20% some months. Here's why:

- International travel








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

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### The Taste of Local on Oregon's Adventure Coast

Farm to table is one thing. But ocean to table? That's what it's all about when you're looking out over the Pacific, especially on Oregon's Adventure Coast - Coos Bay, North Bend and Charleston. Fresh, local cod for fish and chips, clams straight out of Lower Coos Bay, a unique rum made from scratch in small batches - Oregon's Adventure Coast has all of that local flavor and then some.

TASTING TIPS

It only makes sense that local would be on the menu on a stretch of Oregon Coast like this. Coos Bay, North Bend and Charleston all sit perched on the Pacific near some of the best fishing around. Charleston itself is home to one of the largest commercial fishing fleets in all of Oregon, and there's a fresh catch almost every day throughout the fishing seasons

In fact, there's so much local available that it's hard to experience it all in a single day. Instead, an extended overnight or long weekend can provide ample time to taste all the local flavor Oregon's Adventure Coast has to offer.

Consider the Wildflour Pub. Located in the Odd Fellows Building at 1987 Sherman Ave. in North Bend, this charming eatery is a true farm-to-table and ocean-to-table gem. Husband and wife owners Tara and John Moore pride themselves on locally sourced foods, including fresh produce, local beef and the freshest seafood - cod, smoked tuna, salmon and more - from Chuck's Seafood, just steps away from the water in Charleston

Local goes beyond seafood at Oregon's Adventure Coast as well. The southern Oregon Coast is home to nearly 3,000 acres of cranberry cultivation. While many of the 40 million pounds of bright red Oregon cranberries are used in juice or sweetened and dried, Cranberry Sweets & More has been using them in fruity confections for more than 50 years.

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### Local favorites on Oregon's Adventure Coast

Oregon's Adventure Coast in Coos Bay - North Bend - Charle

> 7 Devils Waterfront Alehouse - This waterfront outpost of Coos Bay's premier craft brewery – 7 Devils Brewing – is local to the core. Pacific Ocean seafood in a range of dishes, Coos Bay oysters and even locally grown greens in their Caesar

Stillwagon Distillery – Small-batch, hand-crafted spirits. Classics include a spectrum of Devil's Own Rum – white, gold, spiced, cranberry and others – Whiskey Run Single Malt Whiskey and two kinds of gin. *stillwagondistilleny.com* Back Alley Pub & Grill – A stellar, inviting local pub that's part of an old-school bowling alley with truly elevated pub fare: burgers, pizza, fries, sandwiches and more.

Monkey Business – Sure, this former food cart turned brick-and-mortar joint has a mazing local fish and chips and shrimp tacos, but you'd be depriving yourself of a real coastal treat if you miss their clam chowder. focebook.com/MonkeyBusinessFoodToGo

It started in 1974, when current owner Clayton Shaw's father bought a cranberry candy recipe from a local resident. The recipe was perfected and kicked off Cranberry Sweets' long line of Oregon cranberry treats, from its Original Cranberry Jelly Candies to chocolate-covered cranberries, cranberry tea cookies and gourmet cranberry jelly. The company, which has a factory store in Coos Bay, also crafts an array of chocolates, candies, baking mixes, popcorn, cookies, tarts and other locally inspired goodness.


